ORDINANCE NO. 2026-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY'S GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 2, 2026.

WHEREAS, There came on to be considered the returns of an election held on the 2nd day of May 2026, for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials, and it appearing from said returns that there were cast at said election 119 votes; and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

FOR MAYOR

Daphney Kirby92

FOR CITY COUNCIL POSITION 1

Lee Kosina.....91

FOR CITY COUNCIL POSITION 2

Charlie Keel.....62

Joe Garcia.....51

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

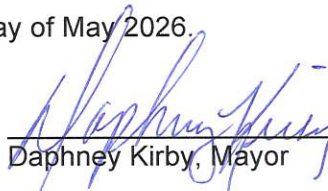
Section 1. The facts and recitations in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purpose.

Section 2. That said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with law; and that this Ordinance declares that Daphney Kirby was duly elected as Mayor, Lee Kosina was duly elected as Council Position 1, and Charlie Keel was duly elected as Council position 2. Exhibit "A" attached hereto contains the election results.

Section 3. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body that the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at three business days before the date of this meeting and as required by the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

Section 4. Severability. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the Ordinance as a whole or any part of provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one of more parts.
