

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-4_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison, Texas Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget was adopted within the time and in the manner required by State law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds and determines that certain budget amendments are required to be adopted for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the proposed changes in the budget are for municipal purposes, and that the amendments of the budget are an emergency and matter of public necessity requiring adoption of the amendments to the budget at this time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

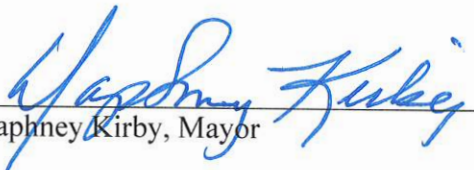
Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this ordinance are found to be true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City of Pattison, Texas Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Budget is hereby amended as shown on Exhibit “A” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes. This amendment to the Budget of the City of Pattison, Texas for the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 shall be attached to and made a part of the Original Budget by the City Secretary and filed as required by State Law.

Section 3. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect,

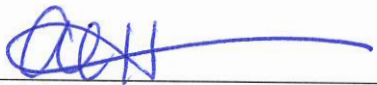
impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
