## ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A MORATORIUM ON AND PROHIBITING ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, CONSTRUCTION OF BILLBOARDS AND OFF PREMISE SIGNS WITHIN THE CITY OF PATTISON UNTIL May 14, 2004, TO ALLOW THE CITY TIME TO REVIEW ITS REGULATION OF SUCH BILLBOARDS AND OFF PREMISE SIGNS IN RELATION TO PUBLIC SAFETY AND PRESERVATION OF LAND VALUES AND LAND USE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison is located approximately five miles north of Interstate 10 in Waller County, Texas in the path of potential development and construction and installation of Billboards and Off Premise Signs, and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to undertake a study of its development to adopt a comprehensive plan as a guide to regulate such Billboards and Off Premise Signs, and future development of property within the City of Pattison; and

WHEREAS, the City plans to undertake studies of its public safety needs and preservation of land use and land values; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pattison has determined that efforts must be made to protect the public safety, health and welfare or its citizens and property within the City along with future development, by regulating the construction of Billboards and Off Premise Signs, to the extent permitted by law; and,

WHEREAS, potential construction of Billboards and Off Premise Signs has raised questions about what criteria the City should adopt to exercise the City's police power with respect to the safety, location of development and, development of the City, and

WHEREAS, insuring public safety, protecting land use, and preserving property values, is an appropriate purpose and basis for the exercise of the police powers of the City; and WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority to adopt a moratorium on the issuance of permits and construction of Billboards and Off Premise Signs for a period until May 14,

2004, during which period the City Council will review the criteria for new regulations and ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the study of the City, and regulation of Billboards and Off Premise Signs, and site development in general is necessary for the public health, safety, welfare, and well being of the citizens of the City of Pattison, and such efforts are time consuming and would be hindered by continued development until solutions are formulated, a moratorium on construction and development of Billboards and Off Premise Signs is required.

I.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the findings and recitals contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are determined to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. A moratorium is hereby adopted effective immediately until

May 14, 2004 during which period the City Council will review the criteria for new regulations and ordinances of Billboards and Off Premise Signs.

- 1. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage, and all Ordinances or portion of Ordinances heretofore passed in conflict with the terms hereof are specifically repealed.

If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, or invalid, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion thereof or provision, or regulation contained herein, shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality of any other person hereof and all provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable for that purpose.

### IV.

The prohibitions set out in this Ordinance shall not apply to any subdivision or development or other related matters which has been approved or which has been filed prior to the date of this Ordinance.

The City Secretary is instructed to post and publish notice of this Ordinance as required by Law, by publishing only the descriptive caption.

review its development, provide for a comprehensive plan, to study the effects of, regulate, and and locate Billboards and Off Premise Signs and land use in relation to such Billboards and Off Premise Signs.
