8. Update from Mayor Garcia on Emergency Management projects.

Mayor Garcia discussed the Emergency preparedness meeting held in April and planned to have another meeting on June 24, 2018. He would like the city to be prepared if and when another disaster comes. He would like the city to be a shelter, stocked with supplies and have volunteers trained for the residents of Pattison.

9. Council to discuss and take action to adopt a Burn Ban Ordinance.
