**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PETITION ON BEHALF OF THE RESIDENTS OF PATTISON THE WALLER HARRIS EMERGENCY SERVICE DISTRICT 200 ("DISTRICT") FOR A SECOND AMBULANCE TO BE LOCATED IN THE PATTISON COMMUNITY TO BETTER SERVE THE SOUTHERN REGION OF WALLER COUNTY, TEXAS.**

**WHEREAS**, the residents of the City of Pattison voted to be included in the District and the residents of the City pay taxes to the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the District was created by the voters to provide emergency services including fire and ambulance services within the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pattison is located in the southern portion of the District which has been identified as an area in Waller County with rapid growth; and

**WHEREAS**, this area of the District has been impacted by several natural disasters effecting many of the residents in the City of Pattison and the southern region of Waller County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes the need for a second ambulance for southern Waller County and for at least one of the two ambulances to be located within the Pattison Community to adequately protect and preserve the health, safety and welfare of all residents in this rapid growth region of Waller County;


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:**


Section 1. Pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 418, the Mayor is the Emergency Management Director for the City of Pattison with the responsibility to coordinate emergency functions: mitigation, preparation, response and recovery from any natural or man-made disaster.

Section 2. The City council recognizes that rapid growth within the southern region of Waller County has resulted in an increased population in our local schools, commercial growth, residential growth, and an increase in vehicular traffic and thus necessitates the need of an additional ambulance to better serve the residents.

Section 3. The ESD currently has one ambulance stationed within the City of Pattison. The City council, on behalf of its citizens, supports the Mayor's continued efforts to petition the District for one more ambulance, and for at least one of the two ambulances to be located within the Pattison Community to adequately protect and preserve the health, safety and welfare of the residents in the southern region of Waller County.
