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I. Call meeting to Order

A regular meeting of the Pattison City Council was called to order by Mayor Joe Garcia at 7:00 p.m. in the Royal ISD Administration Building, located at 3714 FM 359, Pattison, Texas 77466.

IV. Council to approve agenda.

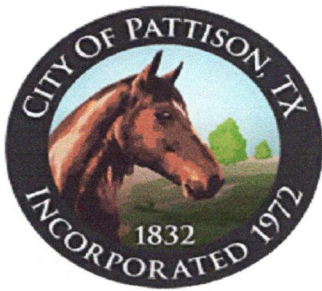
A motion was made by Councilmember MacCallum to approve the agenda as presented. It was seconded by Councilmember Branch. The motion passed unanimously.

V. Consent Agenda

Items listed under the consent agenda are considered routine and are generally enacted in one motion. The exception to this rule is that a Council Member may request one or more items to be removed from consent agenda for a separate discussion and action.

- B. Consent and approval of the finance report for March 2019.**
- C. Consider and take possible action to approve checks paid and payables.**

A motion was made by Councilmember Kircher to approve the consent agenda as presented. It was seconded by Councilmember MacCallum. The motion passed unanimously.



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VI Business:

1. Council to discuss and take action to prioritize drainage projects.

Jared Biermann discussed three options the council could study. Mayor Garcia asked Mr. Biermann to prioritize the drainage projects from the ones that need to be addressed first to the ones that are the least problem areas. No action was taken.

2. Council to discuss and take action to request an Interlocal Agreement with Waller County to clean ditches and culvert.

A motion was made by Councilmember MacCallum to authorize the city attorney to write a letter requesting Waller County to clear the ditches and clean the culverts in all of the Tier one (1) roads in the city. It was seconded by Councilmember Stokes. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Council to discuss and take action on contracting with Sealy Paving to fill potholes.

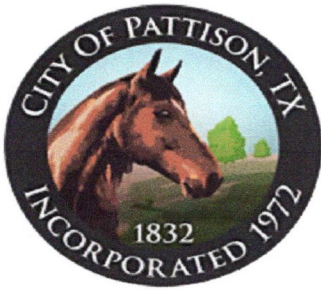
Mayor Garcia will contact Sealy Paving. No action was taken.

A motion was made by Councilmember Kircher to approve the Just Ride for a Just Cause route as presented. It was seconded by Councilmember MacCallum. The motion passed unanimously.



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
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6. Request from council for future agenda items.


Items discussed were Animal Control, setting a workshop to discard out of date city files and to cancel the subdivision ordinance workshop scheduled for March 26, 2019.
