



## Ordinance No. 125

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 124 ESTABLISHING A PLANNING COMMISSION BY AMENDING SECTION 2 TERM OF APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 212 of the Texas Local Government Code requires a municipal authority to approve a plat or replat that is filed under Chapter 212 of the Local Government Code and satisfies all applicable regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 212, "Municipal Regulation of Subdivisions and Property Development," of the Texas Local Government Code provides for the establishment of a City Planning Commission: and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks by the establishment of a Planning Commission to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Pattison, Texas by providing an orderly process for the review of plats and applicable regulations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS THAT:**

**Findings.** That the facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and are adopted as part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

**Sec 1.** Ordinance No. 124 of the City of Pattison, Texas, is hereby amended by replacing Section 2 to provide as follows:

**Sec. 2. Established and Membership.**

**Sec. 2. Appointment and term of office.**

The mayor shall nominate, and by and with the approval of the city council, shall appoint and may remove at any time the members of the planning commission. Each member shall serve for a term of two years, three (3) members to be appointed in every odd-numbered year and four (4) members to be appointed in every even-numbered year. Planning commission members so appointed and approved may be reappointed, subject to approval by city council, following each term of service. Vacancies for the unexpired terms of any member whose position becomes vacant shall be filled by appointment by the mayor, subject to approval by the city council. Newly selected members shall be duly sworn and installed at the earliest possible planning commission meeting or city council meeting after their appointment

**Sec. 3. Adoption and effective date of ordinance.**

This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval and passage.


