

Ordinance No. 126

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR TO OCTOBER 1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30 BEGINNING THE CALENDAR YEAR 2020; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, OR RESOLUTIONS INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 101 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes a General Law Municipality to prescribe the fiscal year of the municipality by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Pattison desires to adopt the fiscal year of October 1 through September 30 for the purpose of compliance with the various Tax Code provisions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to initiate the fiscal year beginning in the calendar year of 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS THAT:

Findings. That the facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found and declared to be true and are adopted as part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

Sec 1. The fiscal year of the City of Pattison is October 1 through September 30 and will take effect in the calendar year of 2020.


Sec. 2. Adoption and effective date of ordinance.
