



## RESOLUTION NO 2020 -02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY; REPEALING ANY RESOLUTIONS, POLICIES AND PRACTICES, WRITTEN OR ORAL, INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:**

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, hereby finds that a specified pile of 14 culverts located at 6<sup>th</sup> street, west of avenue F is surplus property in that the culverts are cracked and old and no longer needed or required for the City's needs.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to remove the 14 culverts from City property for ultimate disposition.


Section 3. The City Council finds that the removal of the surplus culverts accomplishes a public purpose by creating a safe area on the public property and streamlining the removal process.

Section 4. All resolutions and parts of resolutions, policies, rules, regulations, and practices, written or unwritten, of the City of Pattison inconsistent or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.
