



RESOLUTION NO 2020 -006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT TWO GRANT APPLICATIONS TO H-GAC TOTALING \$22,500 EACH WHICH REQUIRES MAYORS SIGNATURE TO CERTIFY GRANT ASSURANCES AND CERTIFICATES REQUIREMENT; REPEALING ANY POLICIES AND PRACTICES, WRITTEN OR ORAL, INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council met on the 7th day of April 2020 pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and submit two grant applications to H-GAC called the following: **City of Pattison Tire Collection Events and City of Pattison Household Waste and E-Scrap Collection Events.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby approve the Mayor's execution and submittal of grant applications to H-GAC and authorizes his signature to certify the required assurances and certifications for the grant application. The grant applications are for the following: **City of Pattison Tire Collection Events and City of Pattison Household Waste and E-Scrap Collection Events.**

SECTION 2. All resolutions and parts of resolutions, policies, rules, regulations, and practices, written or unwritten, of the City of Pattison inconsistent or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.


