



RESOLUTION NO 2020 -008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, REPLACING THE CITY OF PATTISON'S EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN WITH WALLER COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN REVISED; REPEALING ANY POLICIES AND PRACTICES, WRITTEN OR ORAL, INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT WITH THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council met on the 5th day of May 2020 pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute Waller County Emergency Management Plan, revised.

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison adopts Waller County's Emergency Management Plan, revised, in a coordinated effort with Waller County that will be implemented jointly with Waller County and surrounding local municipalities, and as the City of Pattison's Emergency Management Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas:

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby approve the Mayor's execution of Waller County Emergency Management Plan, revised and hereby adopts said Plan as the City of Pattison's Emergency Management Plan, set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. All resolutions and parts of resolutions, policies, rules, regulations, and practices, written or unwritten, of the City of Pattison inconsistent or in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.


