SCHEDULE OF FEES, FOR THE APPLICATION,
PERMIT AND INSPECTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF CELL TOWERS.**

Section 3. The schedule of fees adopted hereby shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this Resolution.

EXHIBIT A

SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR APPLICATION, PERMIT, AND INSPECTIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF CELL TOWER

Application and Permit fees and inspection fees are not refundable.

- 1. Application submittal fee.
The application fee is \$250.00 plus any fees incurred for review and inspection by City Engineer of any construction plans. All information on application shall be complete prior to submittal or the application will be rejected.**
- 2. Before permit is issued, City Engineer will review plans and approve or provide written comments as to why permit shall not be approved. Applicant will comply with recommendations of City Engineer and resubmit construction plans for review.**
- 3. Also prior to permit being issued, the City Engineer will submit to the City an invoice for any professional services provided for the review of tower construction plans. Said invoice shall be submitted to applicant and payment received by the City prior to permit issuance.**
