



RESOLUTION 2021-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO WORK WITH THE CITY OF BROOKSHIRE ON THE EXTRATERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF THE TWO CITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison and City of Brookshire are located near one another; and

WHEREAS, the extraterritorial (ETJ) boundaries of the two cities are in dispute; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison desires to maintain a positive relationship with its neighbor the City of Brookshire; and

WHEREAS, both cities are experiencing rapid growth and development; and

WHEREAS, developers and property owners desire that the ETJ boundaries of the two cities be more clearly defined; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison is willing to release certain land from its ETJ so that such land may be included into the City of Brookshire’s ETJ; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pattison is requesting that the City of Brookshire release certain land from its ETJ to be included into the City of Pattison’s ETJ;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to take any and all lawful action to work with the City of Brookshire on the ETJ boundaries.

SECTION 3. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.


SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force upon passage.
