

## Ordinance No. 152

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS ESTABLISHING PERMITTING FEES FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO FLOOD PLAIN ADMINISTRATION; PROVIDING A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pattison, Texas ("City") desires to establish permitting fees for engineering services related to Flood Plain Administration that ensure the City is recouping its costs for such services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

**Section 1**. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City Council establishes the following fees:

-Permit fees for engineering services related to flood plain administration:

\$125.00 for areas wholly outside of a flood plain; and \$250.00 for areas or parts of areas inside a flood plain.

<u>Section 3.</u> Penalty. Any person who violates or causes, allows, or permits another to violate any provision of this ordinance, rule, or police regulation of the city shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine or penalty not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00). If such rule, ordinance, or police regulation governs fire safety or public health and sanitation, other than the dumping of refuse, the fine or penalty shall not exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). If such rule, ordinance, or police regulation governs the dumping of refuse, the fine or penalty shall not exceed four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00). Each occurrence of any violation of this ordinance, rule, or police regulation shall constitute a separate offense. Each day on which any such violation of this ordinance, rule, or police regulation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 4. Severability. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the city council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or

unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

<u>Section 5</u>. *Effective Date.* This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and enforceable when published as required by law.
