That said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with law and is this Resolution and Order declares that Joe Garcia was duly elected as Mayor, Wayne Kircher was duly elected as Council Position 1, Frank J. Cobio, Jr. was duly elected as Council position 2, and Randall Flowers was duly elected as Council Position 5.

It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body that the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting.
