ORDINANCE 175-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, REPEALING THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, PARKS BOARD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Keep Pattison Beautiful, Inc. a Texas non-profit organization, was formed to partner with Keep Texas Beautiful; and

WHEREAS, the mission of Keep Pattison Beautiful, Inc. is similar to the mission of the City of Pattison, Texas, ("City") Parks Board; and

WHEREAS, to avoid duplication of services and volunteers, the City Council of the City of Pattison finds it in the best interest of the City to repeal the City's Parks Board;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City's Parks Board is hereby repealed.

Section 3. *Severability.*

In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the city council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.


Section 4. *Repeal.*

Ordinance Number 138 and 171 as well as all ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and are hereby repealed only to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. *Effective Date.*

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
