



ORDINANCE NO. 181-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE PATTISON MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pattison, Texas, ("City") City Council called and ordered an election for November 7, 2023, regarding the creation the Pattison Municipal Development District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pattison Municipal Development District is entirely in the extraterritorial limits of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the eligible voters approved the creation of the Pattison Municipal Development District;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATTISON, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

**Section 2.** The City Council appoints the following members to the Board of Directors of the Pattison Municipal Development District along with the terms as set forth below to be staggered 2-year terms:

Position No. 1 Joe Garcia [Name]; term through May 16, 2025; and then City Council shall appoint Position No 1 for a term from May 17, 2025, through May 17, 2027, and then city council shall appoint such Position every two (2) years thereafter.

Position No. 2 Frank Cobio [Name]; term through May 16, 2025, and then City Council shall appoint Position No 2 for a term from May 17, 2025, through May 17, 2027, and then city council shall appoint such Position every two (2) years thereafter.

Position No. 3 Ken Coulter [Name]; term through May 16, 2026, and then city council shall appoint such Position every two (2) years thereafter.

Position No. 4 Sandy Butler [Name]; term through May 16, 2026, and then city council shall appoint such Position every two (2) years thereafter.

Position No. 5 Anissa McGowan [Name]; term through May 16, 2026, and then city council shall appoint such Position every two (2) years thereafter.


**Section 3.** *Severability.*

In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the city council of the City of Pattison, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.

**Section 4.** *Effective Date.*

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
